### 1. CALL TO ORDER

#### 2. OLD BUSINESS

a. Authorization of contract for parking deck repairs

Elliot offered the following resolution, which was seconded by O'Niell.

WHEREAS The upkeep of the Central Parking Deck is the responsibility of the Downtown Development Authority; and

WHEREAS In the spring and fall of 2018, under the direction of consultants WGI Michigan of Kalamazoo (formerly Carl Walker) major renovations were completed at a cost of

\$372,000 to bring the Central Parking Deck to current standards; and

WHEREAS The DDA Board in August 2020 approved a proposal by WGI for what are termed high and moderate priority repairs to the Central Parking Deck, plus the addition of asphalt

repairs, parking space striping and parking block replacement; and

WHEREAS A bid process resulted in RAM Construction of Livonia, MI, the low bid among four

companies that submitted proposals for construction,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Plymouth Downtown Development Authority Board of Directors does hereby authorize DDA staff to contract with RAM Construction of Livonia, MI, for rehabilitation on the Central Parking Deck in the total amount of \$144,427, plus a 10% contingency, for renovation work approved by the DDA Board in August 2020 from Acct. No. 405 290 977 813.
