COVID-19

According to the latest orders from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, beginning Wednesday, November 18 through Monday, December 8, inside dining at restaurants and bars is prohibited. Only outdoor dining and carryout/curbside pickup are allowed. Retail store capacity cannot exceed 30 percent of total occupancy.

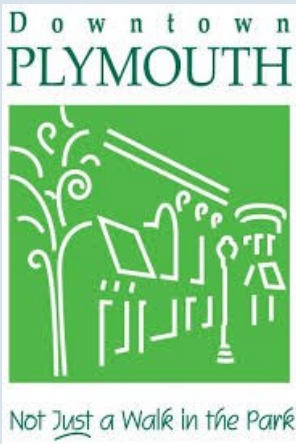

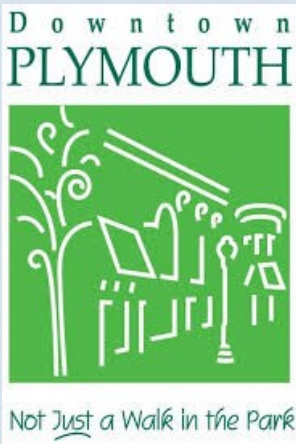

These services will be available Monday through Thursday, from 12 – 7 p.m. and on Friday and Saturday, from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m.

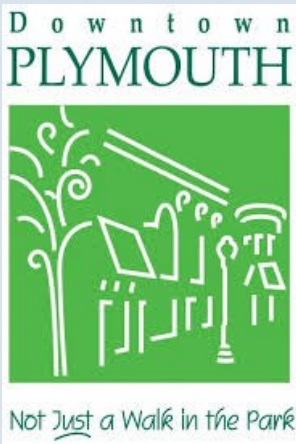

Please come visit our new exhibit "Christmas with the First Ladies." The Plymouth Historical Museum has installed a new air filtration system, installed in by Expert Heating & Cooling. This i-Wave-C air filtration system filters down to .003 microns and filters the air in the museum four times an hour.
