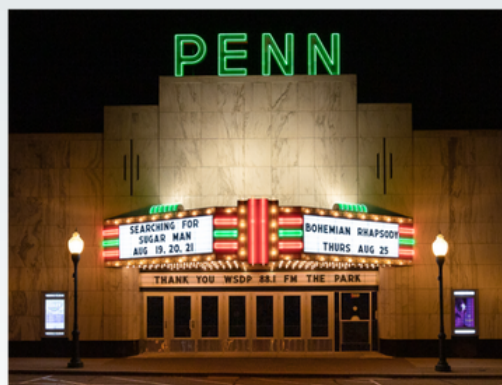




The Gathering

Across the street from Kellogg Park on Penniman Avenue, The Gathering adapts to Downtown Plymouth needs all year. A covered parking structure on most days, it can transform into a marketplace, staging ground for summer concert equipment, even a warming station for visitors to Plymouth's Ice Festival.



Penn Theatre

Located in the heart of Downtown Plymouth, the historic Penn Theatre seats 402 and offers a unique single-screen cinema experience featuring current second run movies, independent films, classic film festivals, free educational school field trips, community events and occasional live musical performances. The Penn Theatre is owned and operated by the Friends of the Penn, a federally recognized non-profit organization.

Historical Interest

Baker House Built by Henry W. Baker in 1875. Baker helped found the Daisy Manufacturing Company, best known for its BB guns.

Conner Building Michael Conner purchased the hardware store at this site in 1857 - it was a popular gathering place in Plymouth village life.

Curtiss House A Stick style wood frame home constructed circa 1890 by builder Charles G. Curtiss Sr. A *Michigan Historic Site listed on the National Register of Historic Places.*

Former U.S. Post Office Westborn Market has been honored for its preservation of this historic site. The post office was built under a New Deal program for job creation during the Great Depression.

Penniman Buildings This commercial block on Penniman earned its nickname, "Phoenix Block" by burning down in 1857 and again in 1893.

Plymouth Historical Museum Since 1948, the Plymouth Historical Society has encouraged research, preservation, and sharing of local history. Also on site: *Chessie Caboose, Fire Tower Bell, Plymouth Plank Road Marker.*

Plymouth Rock The people of Plymouth, England, gifted a piece of their history in honor of the City of Plymouth's Centennial in 1967. A *Michigan Historic Site.*

Plymouth United Savings Bank A Classical Revival building, built in 1920 as the new home of one of the first banks in the area.

Rose of Aberlone A *Michigan Legal Milestone* describing one of the most famous contract cases in U.S. history - starring a cow, Rose 2d of Aberlone.

Wilcox House Built in 1901 by William (Phil) Markham, inventor of the BB Gun. The house was purchased by the Wilcox family ten years later.

Kellogg Park

Wilcox Fountain



Dedicated in October 2021, the Wilcox Fountain in Kellogg Park is a legacy to Jack Wilcox, beloved Plymouth resident. Mr. Wilcox, who passed in 2000, bequeathed his estate for investments in lasting improvements to the Plymouth community. This Plymouth Hall of Famer was tireless in his devotion to the community and was involved in numerous committees, civic and historic groups in the city.
